

SINGAPORE HOSTS THIRD INTERNATIONAL ACCIDENT INVESTIGATION FORUM (19-21 APRIL)

- 1 The Air Accident Investigation Bureau of Singapore (AAIB) will host more than 120 chief aircraft accident investigators, senior investigation officials and experts from over 35 countries and administrations, as well as professionals from the aviation industry, at the 3rd International Accident Investigation (IAI) Forum from 19 21 April 2016.
- Co-organised by and held at the Singapore Aviation Academy (SAA), this triennial IAI Forum has received strong support from the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO), the European Civil Aviation Conference (ECAC), the Flight Safety Foundation (FSF) and the International Society of Air Safety Investigators (ISASI). Mr Calvin Phua, Deputy Secretary (International) of Singapore's Ministry of Transport, will open the forum on 19 April.
- 3 Over the three-day forum, delegates will discuss topics such as the upcoming amendments to ICAO's standards and policies affecting air accident investigation, challenges and lessons learnt from recent major accidents, as well as emerging challenges for safety investigators. Key speakers at this year's forum include Mr Stephen Creamer, Director of ICAO's Air Navigation Bureau, Mr Christopher Hart, Chairman of the United States National Transportation Safety Board, and Dr Soerjanto Tjahjono, Chairman of the National Transportation Safety Committee of Indonesia.
