Factsheet - Naval Logistics Command (NALCOM)

22 Feb 1999

Naval Logistics Command (NALCOM) is one of the four principal ground commands formed in 1986. The other three ground commands are the Fleet, Coastal Command (COSCOM) and Training Command (TRACOM). NALCOM is responsible for all logistics support to the Republic of Singapore Navy (RSN) ships including shore installations.

Within HQ NALCOM, there are seven specialist staff branches responsible for operations, engineering, contracts superintending, quality assurance, manpower, medical and training matters. There are also two maintenance units - Tuas and Brani Maintenance Bases, with a total of 13 workshops, which provide base-level maintenance support to ships under the Fleet and COSCOM.

The Naval Materials and Transport Base provides material, rations and transportation needs for the RSN. The Camp Commandant Office and Medical Centre in each base provide basic essential services to operate and upkeep the infrastructures, amenities, fire prevention, safety and security of the bases.
