SPEECH BY TOH PUAN NOOR AISHAH AT THE OPENING OF THE SINGAPORE CHINESE WOMEN'S ASSOCIATION'S ART AND HANDICRAFT EXHIBITION AT THE VICTORIA MEMORIAL HALL ON FRIDAY, 14TH AUGUST, 1964, AT 11 AM.

First of all I wish to thank the organisers of this Exhibition for having invited me to its opening.

I understand that this Exhibition is organised to display the artistic work of members of the Chinese Women's Association. It is proof of the ability of our womenfolk to organise public functions.
