I am happy to be present here this morning to witness the Road Run organised by the Youth Committee of Geylang East C.C.

Credit must go to the organisers for their initiative and the time spent in organising this event. I am told that the response has been very encouraging. Altogether, about 300 youths will be taking part in the Read Run. The large number of participants is a reflection of the keen interest shown by youths in pursuing healthy recreational activities.

More such activities should be organised on a regular basis for the benefit of youths who form a large proportion of our population. I hope that through participation in such activities the youths will develop keen minds and healthy bodies, both of which qualities are essential for national development.

We know that in many countries the youths have been neglected and left to fend for themselves. Inevitably they land themselves in trouble which very often upset the social order and lead to chaos. This is the sort of thing we do not want in Singapore. It does nobody any good.

Community leaders, therefore, have an important role to play in channelling the energy of youths into healthy recreational activities and other forms of constructive pursuits. The youths themselves must learn to accept what is good and discard what is bad for them. In this way, they will grow up into responsible adulthood.

Nobody owes anybody a living. We all have to organise ourselves and work hard both in work and in play. This is the message I want to pass on to the participants in today's Road Run. I hope you will also tell your friends about it.
