## SPIECH EZ MALLEV INTERSENCE, SENIOR PARLIAMENTARY SECRETARY (NATIONAL DEVELOPMENT) AT THE PRIZE-GIVING CEREMONY OF THE GAPDEN DESIGN COMPETITION AT THE SCHOOL OF ORNAMENTAL HORTICULTURE, BOTANIC GARDENS ON 26 SEPTEMBER 1981 AT 10.30 AM

The Singapore Covernment has spared no efforts in greening the city to schance car living environment. To-date, some 3.8 million trees and sarubs of a nyrelad of colours have been planted by the farks and Peorestion Department. Having achieved substancially the quantitative largets of these planting, a major challenge abeau for the Department in to intensify its efforts to upgrade our landscape with more aesthetic and interesting features. The successful completion of this programme requires a large number of talented landscape architects and supporting staff to design and plan our parks and planting corners along the major pedestrian thorough?cres.

To ensure this, we have an adequate supply of such talents for both the public and private sectors, we need to encourage more young people with an infinite tent to take up landscape architecture as a careon, be is at the producte or supporting technician level. The competition which has just ended is the first of many attempts to generate interist in our young men and women in landscape architecture. The receptse to the competition was fairly good, 51 students and technicians attended the briefing sessions of the competition and 25 of them eventually registered for it. The winning designs, three from students and one from a technician, were selected based on a number of criteria including the artistic ability shown and the concept of the design.

The Funks and Hecreation Department will continue to hold similar competitions to generate interest and spot talents. Another competition will be held some time in December, especially for 'A' level students. Winners will be awarded suitable prizes and encouraged to take up Government scholarships to study landscape architecture in reputable overseas universitien.
