## SINGAPORE-FINLAND AIR SERVICES AGREEMENT

Delegations representing the Government of the Republic of Singapore and the Government of the Republic of Finland met in Singapore from 21 to 23 October 1980 to negotiate an air services agreement.

At the conclusion of the negotiations, a bilateral air services agreement was initialled. The Agreement will allow the designated airlines of both countries to fly, via intermediate points, between Singapore and Finland, and to points beyond.

This liberal Agreement gives the airlines of the two countries greater opportunities to exploit the rights the two Governments have provided for them in the Agreement. This is welcomed by the two airlines in view of the current generally gloomy aviation outlook.

The conclusion of the air services agreement is seen by both Governments as a step towards closer aviation, economic and trade relations. It will also provide a direct service for the benefit of the travelling public.

The Finnish Delegation was led by Mr Erkki Pajari, Ambassador, Ministry of Foreign Affairs, whilst the Singapore Delegation was led by Mr Tan Kwang Hung, Aviation Consultant, Department of Civil Aviation.
