and Serangoon Garden Secondary School

This is an exhibition of creations made with paper and wood by members of the Art Clubs of Parry and Serangoon Garden Secondary Schools. The exhibits are the results of an extensive art programme, which could only be carried out outside normal school hours.

One point that stands out in these exhibits is that all the creations are made from scrap materials of paper and wood, which would be discarded by one who had no use for them. The art students of these two schools are creative enough to turn such scrap materials into objects of various sizes for use as home decorations.

The diversity of exhibits will also show that we do not have to spend much on materials to create these objects, which are artistically imaginative and skilfully made.

The exhibition will be officially opened by Mr Sia Kah Hui, Minister of State for Labour, at the National Museum Young People's Gallery on Thursday 21 February 80 at 3.00 pm.
