## **Cabinet And Other Appointments**

The Prime Minister and his Cabinet colleagues will be sworn into office by the President at 12.00 noon on Saturday, 25 January 1997 at City Hall Chamber.

- 2 Annex I lists the members of the new Cabinet and other office-holders and their portfolios.
- 3 Annex II lists the office-holders by Ministries.
- 4 Dr Tony Tan will take charge of the two universities on behalf of the Minister for Education for the period when the latter is Second Minister for Defence.
- Dr Ow Chin Hock's and Dr John Chen's appointments will take effect in about two months' time, to enable them to wind up their outstanding commitments with their present employers.

- Or John Chen's appointment will be for half the term as he has private sector commitments after that. He is required to assist the Minister for Communications in specific assignments.
- The Prime Minister has appointed several Members of Parliament (MPs) from the National Trades Union Congress (NTUC) as office-holders after consultation with Mr Lim Boon Heng, Secretary-General of NTUC. These MPs will bring into Government their valuable experience from working with the labour movement. Several of them will return to NTUC later, after acquiring first-hand how the Government works, as Mr Goh Chee Wee has done. Such cross-postings will benefit both the Government and NTUC.
- There will be a second Cabinet change within two years. The reason for this two-stage change is to enable the Minister for Communications and Minister for National Development to remain in their present Ministries to see through and ensure the smooth implementation of certain major programmes, including Electronic Road Pricing and the Housing and Development Board (HDB) Upgrading.
- It will also allow several of the new Members of Parliament with officeholder potential to find their feet and gain experience as backbenchers and to build up their links with their constituents, before they are appointed to office.
