Tickets for 3rd ASEAN Schools Games 2011 Available from 27 June

1. Tickets to watch the 3rd ASEAN Schools Games (ASG) and the Opening Ceremony will be available for collection from 27 June. To enable as many people as possible to participate and support the ASG, the tickets will be given out free.

2. The 3rd ASG will be held in Singapore for the first time from 1 to 7 July 2011. The ASG Opening Ceremony will also mark the opening of the Singapore Youth Festival, which will be held on 1 July 2011 at 7.30pm at The Max Pavilion. Please refer to [Annex A](#) or the ASG website (www.aseanschoolsgames2011.sg) for the Games competition schedule.

3. There are around 12,500 tickets available for the competitions and 500 available for the Opening ceremony. Interested members of the public may obtain their free tickets at least one day before each event at the MOE Co-Curricular Activities Branch reception counter at 21 Evans Road, on Mondays to Fridays from 8.30am to 6pm. Each member of the public can collect a maximum of 10 tickets, issued on a first-come-first-served basis. Tickets for competitions will be issued in half-day slots (AM or PM).

4. Members of the public who do not manage to collect a ticket beforehand may approach the staff at the venues to enquire about availability of seats. Subject to availability of seats, walk-in spectators can enter the venue 20 minutes after the competitions have started. 5. Singapore students will be able to watch the Games and cheer the athletes on at the competitions. All primary and secondary schools, junior colleges and centralised institute have been invited to watch the Games. Around 50 percent of the seats have been allocated to schools at their request. Special education schools and pre-schools are also invited to watch the Games, and can request for tickets if they wish to bring their students to the competitions.

6. Through the ASG, the Ministry of Education seeks to promote the benefits of sports to our students, building on the impetus and positive buzz that was generated from the Asian Youth Games and Singapore 2010 Youth Olympic Games. It also aims to provide a meaningful and memorable experience for the athletes and students as part of their holistic development.

7. Besides taking part as spectators and learning more about ASEAN in their schools, some 2,200 students will be closely involved in supporting the operations in specific roles and as volunteers. Their different roles will include flag bearers, first aiders and helpers for the various sports, as well as student journalists.
