BY THE MINISTRY OF CULTURE

The Ministry of Culture will publish a journal of creative writing. The publication will appear twice a year in December and June. The first issue is expected to be published in December this year. About 2,000 copies will be printed of each issue.

An editorial committee of nine has been appointed. Poet and painter, Mr Arthur Yap, Lecturer in English at the University of Singapore is the General Editor of the Journal. A panel of four will act as advisors to the editorial committee. The name of the journal will soon be decided by the editorial committee.

The publication will be in English, but will include translations of work written in the other three languages, Malay, Mandarin and Tamil. It will feature, in the main, original creative writing by Singaporeans. Critical pieces will be confined to periodic reviews or surveys of the writing scene. Poetry, short stories, excerpts of longer fiction (or works-in-progress), and plays will be accepted for publication. Contributors and translators will receive an honorarium for work published in the journal.

Esso Singapore Pte Ltd will fund the publication through six issues.
