## Security Measures at Jurong Island

Security measures for Singapore's key civil and military installations are constantly reviewed and enhanced, particularly since September 11 last year. The Singapore Police Force (SPF) and the Singapore Armed Forces (SAF) work in close co-ordination to ensure that these security measures are comprehensive and robust, in the light of the generally raised level of threat.

Our security agencies have tightened up border controls and stepped up cargo and immigration checks at all land, sea and air entry and exit points into Singapore. Additional visa requirements have been implemented. The Police have also increased the frequency of their patrols.

The Government has also enhanced security measures for the protection of key installations. This includes the deployment of SAF troops to augment SPF resources. Recently, SAF troops were deployed to protect Jurong Island, where they conduct regular patrols. The SAF also works closely with the Police Coast Guard, which conducts maritime patrols in the waters

around Jurong Island, and with the management of JTC Corporation and the resident commercial companies to ensure a very high level of security for Jurong Island.
