Army Demonstrates Operational Readiness in Open Mobilisation Exercise

26 Jan 2003



Operationally-Ready NSmen reporting back to Pasir Ris Camp for in processing during today's Army open mobilisation exercise.

The Army conducted its first open mobilisation exercise for 2003 this afternoon. The scheduled exercise involved some 2050 servicemen, including Full-time National Servicemen, NSmen and regulars from the Army's 10th Singapore Infantry Brigade (10 SIB).

The servicemen were activated at 12pm today. By the end of the mobilisation exercise, over 90 % of the servicemen had reported back to their units.

The SAF regularly conducts such mobilisation exercises to evaluate the operational readiness of SAF personnel and equipment. The mobilised units are put through a series of inspections, physical fitness tests or exercises, to validate their overall readiness. The good turnout today demonstrates the readiness and commitment of our active and NS personnel.
