Former Australian Chief of Air Force Receives Military Medal

Former Australian Chief of Air Force, Air Marshal (Retired) Errol John McCormack, received the Pingat Jasa Gemilang (Tentera) [Meritorious Service Medal (Military)] from the Minister for Defence, Rear-Admiral (NS) Teo Chee Hean, at the Ministry of Defence this morning. Air Marshal (Retired) McCormack was awarded the medal in recognition of his significant role in fostering closer ties between the Royal Australian Air Force (RAAF) and the Republic of Singapore Air Force (RSAF).

Under the leadership of Air Marshal (Retired) McCormack, the RAAF provided excellent support to the RSAF for its flight training in Pearce Air Base and Tamworth. The RSAF also benefited from participating in the multilateral exercise codenamed Pitch Black and from access to facilities for Unmanned Aerial Vehicle training in Australia. The various interaction programmes at both the senior and working levels further contributed to the professional development of the RSAF. Air Marshal (Retired) McCormack's support for the various exercises and activities was instrumental in enhancing inter-operability between the two air forces.
