TEXT OF SPEECH BY H.E. THE YANG DI-PERTUAN
NEGARA, TUN YUSOF BIN ISHAK, ON THE OCCASION
OF THE ANNUAL GENERAL INSPECTION OF THE ST.
JOHN AMBULANCE BRIGADE AT THE JALAN BESAR
STADIUM ON SUNDAY, AUGUST 9, AT 5 P.M.

It gives me great pleasure to come here this evening to take the annual general inspection of the St. John Ambulance Brigade. We are all well aware of the great service St. John is rendering in Singapore and its record of service is a most impressive one. Faithful to its motto: "For the Service of Mankind" the way in which it tries to live up to its humanitarian ideals is well known. The familiar khaki uniforms of the ambulance men and the neat white uniforms of the nurses are to be seen in all emergencies and at public functions. All its members are voluntary workers and the people of Singapore should be very grateful to these volunteers whose selfless devotion to duty is worthy of the highest praise and deserving of the utmost support.
