SPEECH BY THE FIRST LADY, MRS. B.H. SHEARES, AT THE SINGAPORE SOCETSU ASSOCIATION EXHIBITION TO BE HELD AT THE N.T.U.C. CONFERENCE PALL ON 2ND SEPTEMBER, 1971 AT 5.30 P.M.

I am happy to be here this evening to open the Singapore Sogithur Association Exhibition of Flower Arrangement. The Singapore Sogetsu Association was founded in 1950 by Mrs. K. Kim, its President. It was established as a Chapter of the Sogetsu School in Tokyo by Miss Ogawa in 1966. Since its inception the membership has grown steadily and today, there are nearly 200 Ordinary and Associate members actively participating in the Association's many functions. The frequent social gatherings that the smaller Exhibitions of Flower Arrangements bring members of all nationalities tegether for an exchange of ideas and sharing of experience in a friendly atmosphere.
