OFFICIAL OPENING OF MEMBINA PRIMARY SCHOOL

1 The Ministry of Education is pleased to announce the official opening of Membina Primary School. The school, which is situated at the junction of Jalan Membina and Jalan Bukit Merah, will be declared open by Mr Lai Tha Chuai, Member of Parliament for Henderson, on Friday, 16th July 1976 at 1900 hours. The building was completed in December 1974 and the school commenced to function as from January, 1975. It is the 113th school built by the present government and it cost 1.1 million dollars.

2 Membina Primary School is the first school of the contemporary design built under the Education Ministry's reactivated School Building Programme. It has a four-storey building with 24 spacious classrooms and 3 special rooms, a single storey block with a canteen cum assembly hall, and another single storey building which contains the Teachers' Common Room, a General and Principal's Office, a Dental Clinic and a sick bay. The school offers primary education in the English and Tamil media. It has an enrolment of 1817 pupils and a staff of 56 teachers and 7 non-teaching personnel.
