CEMEMONY AT FRENCH ROAD CONTRACT 1 AFARTMENT BLOCKS 601

AND 602 ON 5 CCTCDER 1978 AT 11.30 AM

We will witness today the balloting of the first 100 units of 3-room flats in this latest HDD development in Jalan Desar constituency. - the French Road Complex which is bounded by King George's Avenue, Horne, Jellicoe, French and Kitchener Reads. Also completed together with those 100 units are 20 shops with living quarters, 1 cating house with living quarters and 16 lock-up shops.

As you can see around, construction is still underway for the major part of French Road Complex. Under construction now are 180 1-room units, 176 2-room, 264 3-room and 96 5-room flats. Together with more than 100 shops, these units are expected to be ready around mid 1900. The HDD also has proposals for another 350 units of 3- and 4-room flats for this complex together with another 100 or so shops.

If these projectles are carried out, the entire French Road Complex will have a gross commercial area of some 25,000 m² with about 250 shops of various types and a total of 1,160 units of flats. French Road Complex in fact would be the first public housing project in the constituency with 5-room flats.

We have thus come a long way from the early days when the only public housing units around were the SIT flats in Jalan Bosar estates. The URA has also built some units in Syed Alwi, Petain, French and Maude Reads, but the HDB developments here in the French Road Complex and Kelantan Centre near Recher Canal are to date the most ambitious projects ever.

We, who are intimately associated with this constituency, should strive towards a more gracious way of living. Given a better environ we should work hard to create for curselves a bright new image. Slovenliness and sheddy habits should be discarded. Residents must realise that good neighbourhiness must accompany highrise living. Let us all take pride in kee, in ; our constituency clean and litter free, making it a harmonicus and pleasant place to call our own.
